Candidates have been surveyed and rated by Illinois Right To Life Action (IRLA) with respect to pro-life issues (abortion, assisted suicide, embryonic stem cell research and related issues). - \* = An asterisk indicates incumbent.
- 3 = Will not support most Pro-life issues
- 4 = Totally opposed to Pro-Life issues
- # = Rape and/or Incest Exception
